

Veterinary Clinic Renovation



- 1. Hoisting & Access Plan: We have learned that each building is unique, which can make it difficult to hoist materials and accessing each space is challenging. CGI will provide a hoist plan.
- 2. Interference & Constructability: This coordination can proactively define trouble areas and help reduce or eliminate issues. We will check HVAC, electrical, I.T., and security, the source of most conflicts on Healthcare projects.
- **3. Constructability** Analysis & Review: Being proactive in identifying potential constructability and infection control early on will reduce the risks of cost overruns and safety issues.
- **4. Cost Estimating & Control:** CGI will provide a reliable cost estimate of what it will take to complete the project, with a recommended contingency that makes sense. We can work backwards as well if a budget is in place.
- 5. Scheduling, Phasing, & Logistics: CGI will use our expertise to more accurately determine milestones for coordinating every aspect and accomplishing

- each phase of construction. Including deliveries, shut downs, phasing, hoarding, interference with the helipad and ambulance.
- **6. Bid Packaging:** As part of the preconstruction process, any pertinent construction documents are packaged together to identify the scope of work that will be required.
- 7. Risk Management: CGI ensures that contracts are written up properly, all regulations are abided by, and that the design, materials, and jobsite comply with expectations and standards which is critical to avoid litigation, fines, or costly mistakes. This includes Infection Control & COVID plans.
- 8. Subcontractor Pre-qualification & Selection:
 Pre-qualifying and building relationships with subcontractors takes time, but is worth the effort and helps keep your project on time and on budget. This also ensures our experience with Infection control and COVID vaccination compliance.


